The Atwood Avenue corridor also features Olbrich Park and the Olbrich Botanical Gardens, two of Madison's most popular outdoor destinations. (Eastmorland Park, Ontario Park, and O.B. The Capital City State Trail bicycle route runs through the neighborhood, connecting Eastmorland to many miles of trail throughout the city.
