

Lake Mills, WI

Lake Mills sits south of Interstate 94, roughly 25 miles east of Madison. The community includes Rock Lake to the west and the Glacial Drumlin State Trail passes through the northern end of town. Homes in Lake Mills are varied. There is a wide variety of affordable single family homes, along with luxury options around Rock Lake and the nearby Lake Mills golf club, with most being found along the main roads leading to downtown. Newer construction and single family homes are found along the east and north sides of town. Luxury lakefront homes and cottages are along the west side on Rock Lake.

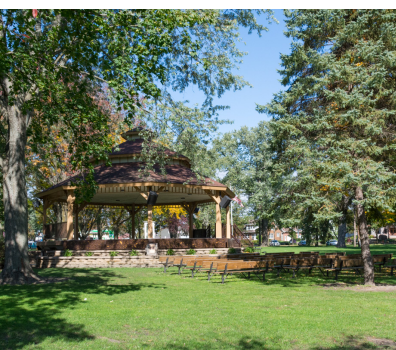

The downtown is shaped as a triangle, and includes Commons Park, right in the center. Lake Mills has an Arts Alliance that works to create and maintain art throughout town. Ephraim Pottery, a popular regional arts and crafts style potter, calls Lake Mills home. To the west is Rock Lake, offering opportunities for boating and fishing. Local legend debates the existence of pyramids at the lake's bottom. Rock Creek connects to the lake, and runs through the town.



Parks & Recreation

The community is close-knit, and hosts marathons, farmers markets, and an annual winter gathering, the Knickerbocker Ice Festival. The festival includes activities on the ice on Rock Lake, like fishing, golfing, and snowshoeing. Community parks offer opportunities for hiking, biking, and camping during the warmer months.



Schools

The Lake Mills Area School District offers an elementary, middle, and high school in town. In addition, Lakeside Lutheran High School offers a private education, and attracts students from all over the region.
