Edgerton, WI

Edgerton is located about 22 miles south of Madison, and about 12 miles north of Janesville in south central Wisconsin.

The community lies mostly in Rock County, although a small northern section is part of Dane County.

A large number of historic homes are found here, built in the late 1800s, early 1900s, and additional construction continuing through the 1900s. More modern homes can be found as you move away from the downtown area. The community boasts a rich history, commitment to the arts, and close proximity to Lake Koshkonong and the Rock River. A significant portion of the real estate in Edgerton is historic homes. Farmhouses and bungalows are found along the town's center. Move further out and you'll find a good selection of ranch and more modern two-story homes. Larger homes

and newer construction can be found around Lake Koshkonong and along the Rock River.













Events and Activities

Edgerton is a close knit community with a population of just over 5,000. The town boasts a strong commitment to the arts. The Edgerton Performing Arts Center is located in the High School, but offers a state of the art stage and equipment designed to host large scale events. Regular performances are hosted here, bringing in a wide range of regional artists and musicians. Outdoor enthusiasts enjoy boating and fishing at Lake Koshkonong, a natural 10,595 acre lake located just east of town. The lake connects to the Rock River, which flows south of town and is a popular place for kayaking, tubing, and fly fishing.

Schools

The Edgerton School District includes three schools: Edgerton Community Elementary School, Edgerton Middle School and Edgerton High School. The schools sit together along Elm High Drive.
