Parks & Recreation

The scenery surrounding Mount Horeb real estate provides the perfect backdrop for the village's 18 parks and recreational facilities. Outdoor attractions include Blue Mound State Park (home to southern Wisconsin's highest point) and the Military Ridge State Trail. The Cave of the Mounds – a national landmark – is a popular destination for underground education and exploration. Mount Horeb also offers a community aquatics center, rinks for ice skating and hockey, skiing at Tyrol Basin, and golfing at the Deer Valley Lodge in nearby Barneveld. Other local attractions include the Mount Horeb Area Museum and the Little Norway National Historic Place. Both offer a view of the village's heritage, which includes Norwegian, Native American, German, Irish, and Scottish roots.

Community celebrations are a way of life in Mount Horeb, where the festival season kicks off each year with the Summer Frolic in early June. The Frolic is only the beginning of the festival season. Other events and celebrations include the Taste of Mount Horeb, the Annual Art Fair, Cajun Fest, the Thirsty Troll Brew Fest, the Fall Heritage Festival, the Holiday Craft Bonanza, the Norsk Run, and the Spring Art Tour. The residents of Mount Horeb clearly know how to have a little fun!



Schools

The Mount Horeb Area School District offers 5 schools in total. The Early Learning School serves children in pre-school and kindergarten; the Primary Center serves grades 1 and 2. The Intermediate Center serves grades 3-5, while the Middle School (6-8) and the High School (9-12) serve children at the older levels.
