Variety abounds in Verona. The “old-town” neighborhoods near the center of town feature sturdy ranch and bungalow style homes dating back to the middle of the century. Just out from town center, you’ll find a great variety of two-story colonial, contemporary, and transitional homes. Many neighborhoods were built in the late 1990s or more recently. Newer homes, modern floor plans, and buildable lots are available in Westridge, Cathedral Point, Hawthorne Hills, and others. Verona is growing rapidly, and buyers will find many opportunities in the expanding neighborhoods.



Parks & Recreation

Adult and youth athletes alike will love the recreational opportunities in and around Verona. Reddan Soccer Park, a 60 acre park run by the Madison Area Youth Soccer Association, provides excellent practice and game space. Ceniti Park includes a Little League baseball and softball complex. The Verona Ice Arena provides an Olympic sized ice rink, with youth hockey and figure skating lessons. The Verona Athletic Center (VAC) includes gymnasiums for indoor sporting events like basketball and volleyball. Swimming facilities can be found at both the Goodman Aquatic Center and the indoor Natatorium. The parks department boasts at least 25 parks, with the number increasing as neighborhoods expand. Fireman’s Park includes a swim beach. Two others, Harriet Park and the space adjacent to the Ice Arena, offer outdoor ice rinks each winter. Outdoor enthusiasts will appreciate access to the rambling Sugar River, Pope Farms Conservancy, the Military Ridge State Trail, and the Ice Age National Scenic Trail.

Schools

With a mix of seven traditional schools and four charter schools, the Verona Area School District is the 28th largest in the state. The Verona Area High School has a 15:1 student-teacher ratio, and is ranked #26 within Wisconsin by U.S. News & World Report.
